NICARAGUA TOURS

Day 1

Arrive in the international airport in Managua. Meet and greet your guide. Private transfer to your hotel in Leon.

Day 2

Breakfast.

In the morning we do a walking tour in this fascinating Colonial city to visit historical monuments and buildings. Leon was First capital of the republic for long time. It was founded by the Spanish in 1524 and relocated from its original location near to Sutiaba.

During this tour we visit building such as the largest cathedral in Central America awarded World Heritage Site status by (UNESCO) and the second oldest university in Central America, the museum of Ruben Dario, considered undisputable Father of Modernism Literature Movement. Leon is well known as the First city of Nicaragua that defeated the former National Guard in June 1979.

Lunch.

Later on, we head to the Las Peñitas beach, you will have time to enjoy the beach, relax, have a fresh seafood dinner and watch the sunset!

Here you start on motor boat trip to explore the Juan Venado Island. During this tour you will sightsee and learn about the three kinds of mangrove forests. Watch a great variety of aquatic birds, reptiles like green and black iguanas.

Dinner.

Overnight accommodation in your hotel in Leon

Day 3

Breakfast.

Discover the world of rum on the tour of the Flor de Cana rum factory, considered the most famous Nicaraguan rums as well as one of the finest in the world!

Learn about the Rum process. We will discover the traditions and heritage of Central America's leading brand, founded in 1890.

Lunch.

This is your chance in the afternoon to hike the youngest and most active volcano in Nicaragua and Central America. The last eruption was in 1999.

We will hike to the top in approximately 1 hour, take a little time to take in the majestic views of the volcanic mountain range and then board down the outside of the volcano on its sand slope.

You won't want to miss this amazing and unique opportunity, complete with a truly unique adrenaline rush and amazing views.

Optional: Sand boarding or walking

Overnight accommodation to your hotel in Leon

Day 4

Breakfast.

We take a Morning private transport toward the city in Granada.

A horse-drawn carriage city tour, there are many colonial buildings to visit, including its cathedral, the old rail stations that connected the Corinto Port to Granada, learn about La casa de la Polvora (Gunpowder house) built by the Spanish in 1748 and the Showdown for power by US Mercenary William Walker in 1856. Later we visit the Cemetery of Granada which guards former presidents of the country under marble stones.

Lunch.

As Follows, we take a motor boat tour in the lake of Nicaragua, a stunning and gorgeous spot of many small islands. Archipelago is composed of 360 islands.

Overnight accommodation in your hotel in Granada.

Day 5

Breakfast.

This day we go to the San Juan de Oriente, these are very famous for their crafts on pottery, woods and fabrics. We will visit different workshops and see their work in live. Visit to Masaya market a colorful and unique place of craftsmanship, a place that should not be missed at all to go shopping native souvenirs.

Later on we drive to the Laguna de Apoyo to have lunch and spend the afternoon swimming, kayaking or simply relaxing.

In the evening we head to visit Masaya Volcano National Park, this volcano is very popular for showing its incredible geothermal activity in live.

Overnight accommodation in your hotel in Granada.

Day 6

Breakfast.

You go by car to visit the Mombacho volcano cloud forest Reserve. This dormant volcano of incredible biodiversity is 1,400 meters high; you will see orchids, endemic reptiles and observe the City of Granada, the Islets, Asese Peninsula, and more. Furthermore, you will see and feel fumaroles. There are 193 bird species (37 migratory), 47 mammals' species, 36 reptiles' species and 10 amphibians.

Lunch.

We go toward San Jorge port to get on a Ferry to Ometepe Island, a Biosphere Natural Reserve. It is considered the world's largest island

in a freshwater lake, the Cocibolca, and a paradise by the Nicaraguan authorities, for their diversity and lush beauty.

The island has abundant pre-Columbian archaeological remains - petroglyphs, statues, ceramics attest to the antiquity of human settlements on its soil.

Dinner.

Overnight accommodation to your hotel in Ometepe.

Day 7

Breakfast.

Tour to San Ramon waterfall, a beautiful waterfall cascading over mossy rocks into a small pool, a car will take you to the start point, and then there is a one hour easy level trekking to the top to enjoy the nature.

Lunch.

After lunch you will be visiting Ojo de Agua, this is home to two pool fed by thermal spring water. This natural pool is surrounded by a small forest and palm huts. You can swim as long as you wish.

Overnight accommodation to your hotel in Ometepe.

Day 8

After breakfast, transfer to Merida, considered one of Nicaraguan best spot to go kayaking. This river will give you the pleasure to see the amazing views of this paradise island. During this activity you will

sightsee birds, lush aquatic flora, and with luck cuajipal (a type of caiman)

Day 9

Breakfast.

Towards Charco Verde Ecological Park, take a 2 hours walk in this nature; visit a butterfly garden with different species of butterflies that live in Ometepe: Blue Morpho, Monarch, Owl butterfly and more. After the garden we move into the park trails where you can see howler monkeys, birds, reptiles, giant trees, lagoon, beach and beautiful lookouts.

Lunch.

Then they move to the famous Punta Jesus Maria, a beautiful resort formed by the accumulation of volcanic sand which was swept away by the currents of the lake. Today this sandy peninsula reaches up to a kilometer long in the summer with beautiful views of the two volcanoes where you will enjoy a spectacular sunset.

Dinner.

Overnight accommodation to your hotel in Ometepe

Day 10

Breackfast.
